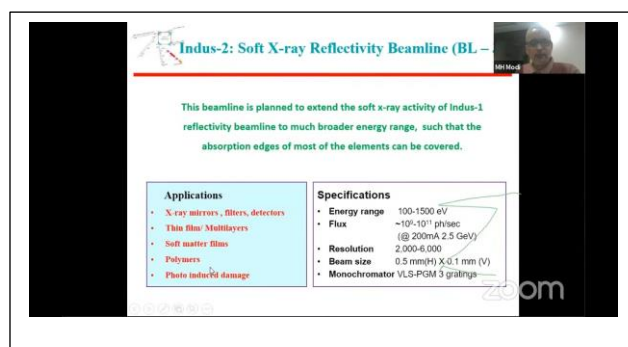
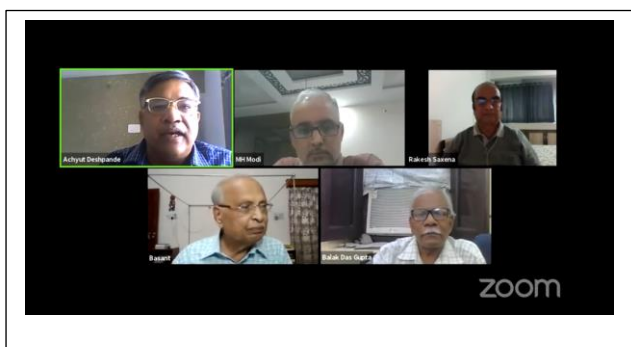


College Activities:

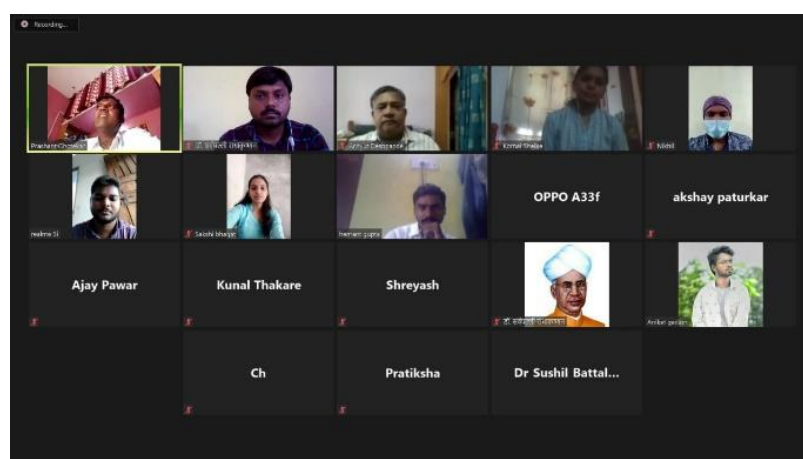
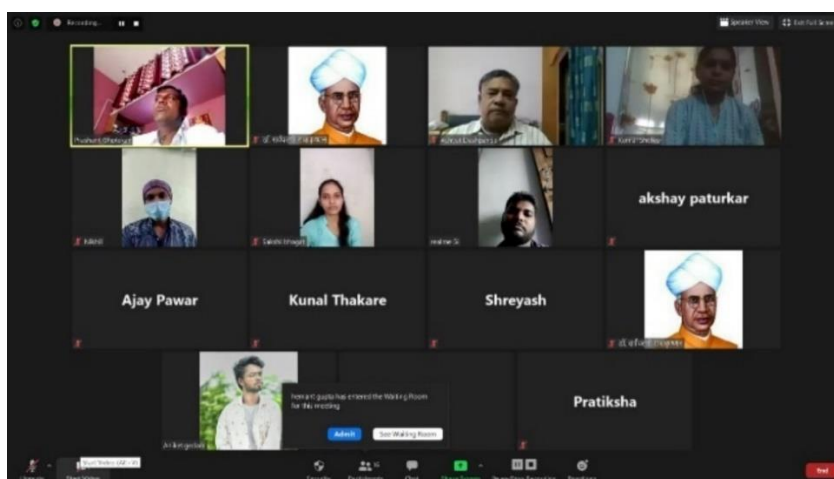

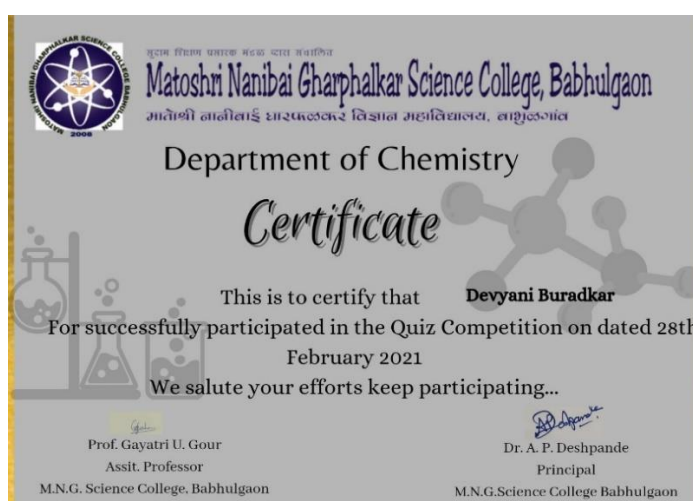

- National Science Day:

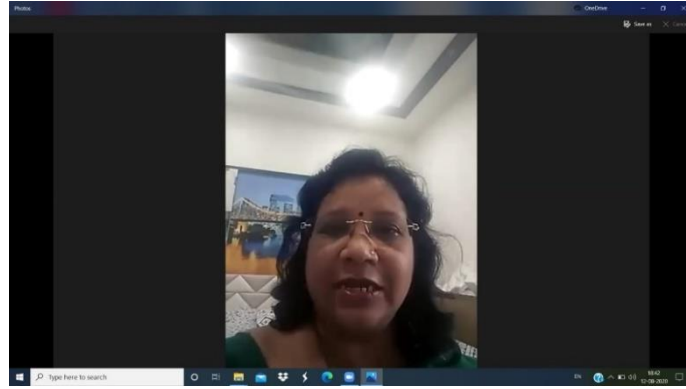

- National Librarian Day:

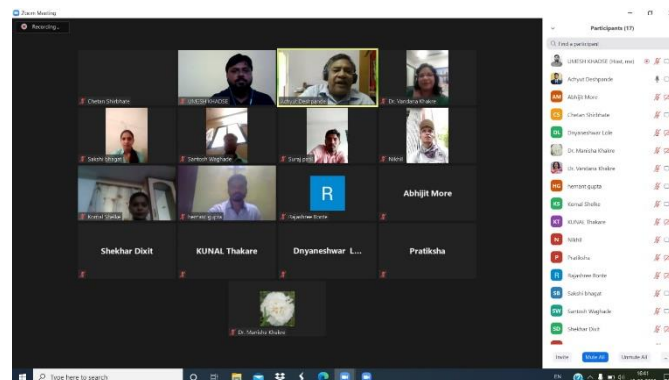
